1) Mt Kelly Cemetery clean-up
 Volunteers will leave from Sacred Heart and travel to Mt. Kelly Cemetery located on Cherry Hill and Martha Street. Transportation is by car-pool or on your own. Volunteers will be working outside doing clean-up and grounds work throughout the cemetery. Bring gloves. *(If we have inclement weather, this project will be cancelled and you will be assigned to your second choice.)*

2) St. Sebastian Food Pantry Reorganizing & Cleaning
 Volunteers will leave from Sacred Heart and travel to St. Sebastian located at 20710 Colgate, Dearborn Heights. Transportation is by carpool or on your own. Volunteers will be helping organize and clean shelves, defrosting freezers, etc.

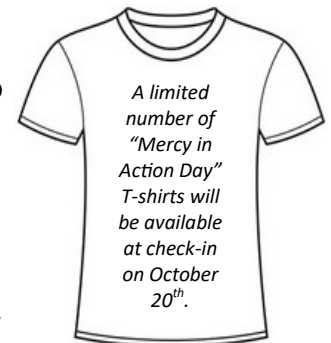
3) Sacred Heart Church cleaning
 Volunteers will work in the Church vacuuming, dusting, washing woodwork and pews, etc.

4) Blessing Bag item collection and assembly
 Volunteers will work in the Parish Hall assembling bags of items to be given to the homeless who come to the Parish Office.

5) Wrapped-In-Prayer Blanket Making
 Volunteers will work in the parish hall making no-sew fleece blankets which will be given to those baptized at Sacred Heart Parish during the year. While you work, you are asked to offer prayer for the one who will receive this blanket thus wrapping them in warmth and prayer.

6) Blood Drive volunteer
 Volunteers will work in the Parish Hall helping with set-up, greeting donors, and assisting donors in the refreshment area. (Training provided on site.)
